confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, tributary of WILLOW CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 55.20 ACRES OF LAND.

This right was perfected under Permit U-408. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 11, 1951.

The use is limited to 0.69 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or it's equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

#12- Moody Well: 1400 feet South and 30 feet East from the NW corner of Section 14, being within the SW¼NW¼, Section 14, Township 15 South, Range 42 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
