CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary of MALHEUR RIVER for IRRIGATION of 12.80 ACRES OF LAND.

This right was perfected under Permit 47843. The date of priority is JUNE 9, 1983.

The use is limited to 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or it's equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

#11- Smith Ditch: 2250 feet West from the NE corner of Section 31, being within the NW¼ NE¼, Section 31, Township 15 South, Range 43 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The use shall confirm to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
