CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DRY GULCH DITCH COMPANY
ROUTE 1, BOX 102A
RICHLAND, OR 97870

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 6.00 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2495.

The date of priority is June 9, 1915.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.075 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

#6 Powder River SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T9S, R44E, W.M.; 790' East and 1040' North from the Southwest corner of Section 13, T9S, R44E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

G. & L. Shold, Tax Lot 1700
0.80 Acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
5.00 Acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.20 Acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 13
Township 9 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate supersedes Certificate 2209 and confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on FEB 16 1999 approving a petition by Dry Gulch Ditch Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.
