CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILSON DITCH COMPANY
c/o BINK RAMOS
860 ARDITH
STANFIELD, OREGON 97875

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 7.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is DECEMBER 15, 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

WILSON DITCH.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.0 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 6.0 ACRES
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

This certificate, together with Certificates 75449, 75450, and 75451, describe the portions of the water rights confirmed by Certificate 2648, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 16 1998, approving Transfer Application 7577.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
