confirms the right to use the waters of McKAY CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 15.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is APRIL, 1898.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 33 of the decree, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ 10.0 ACRES NW¼ SW¼ 5.0 ACRES SECTION 18 TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
