CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of FANNO CREEK, for the IRRIGATION OF 4.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit No. 21649. The date of priority is AUGUST 29, 1952. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, T 2 S, R 1 W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.4 ACRES
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior Certificate 27594, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 18 1998.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610, pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
