CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ELWOOD M. NELSON  
17850 PEERLESS LOOP  
NEHALEM, OR 97131

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of MIAMI RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA.

This right was perfected under Permit 42462. The date of priority is OCTOBER 5, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 2 N, R 10 W, W.M.; 1210 FEET NORTH AND 778 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 25  
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
