CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CRUISER SPRING, a tributary of CRANE CREEK, for STOCKWATER.

This right was perfected under Permit 50494. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 19, T 16 S, R 35 E, W.M.; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 400 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 19.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4)  
SECTION 19  
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
