CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of Big Muddy Creek, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 54.00 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1886 for 40 ACRES and 1900 for 14 ACRES.

The use is limited to 1.35 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Long Eilertson Ditch: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 2640 feet South and 150 feet East from Northwest Corner, Section 20, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
