CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CLARENCE AND MAXINE BECKER
ROUTE 1, BOX 662
MONROE, OREGON 97456

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 44.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4757. The date of priority is DECEMBER 3, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL #2 - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 22, WELL #3 - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, WELL #4 - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN COFFEE DLC 68, SECTION 23, T 14 S, R 5 W, W.M.; WELL #2 - 800 FEET SOUTH AND 160 FEET EAST, WELL #3 - 570 FEET SOUTH AND 2370 FEET EAST, WELL #4 - 840 FEET SOUTH AND 3120 FEET EAST, ALL FROM THE SW CORNER OF OLIVER DLC 47.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

AS PROJECTED WITHIN COFFEE DLC 68
LOT 5 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) 3.7 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.4 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN COFFEE DLC 68
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 42177, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 25 1998, approving Transfer Application 7109

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
