CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.F. ZIMMERMAN, R.L. SMITH AND HAROLD BARTSCH PENDLETON, OREGON 97801

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for DOMESTIC, LIVESTOCK AND IRRIGATION OF 73.57 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1894 for 34.57 acres and 1907 for 39.0 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.919 cubic feet per second (cfs), being 0.432 cfs for 1894 and 0.487 CFS FOR 1907, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversions are located as follows:

W.F. ZIMMERMAN - SE¼ NW¼, SECTION 21, T 2 N, R 32 E, WM; SOUTH 28° 10' WEST, 1627 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER OF THE NW¼, SECTION 21;

C.R. SMITH - NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 21, T 2 N, R 32 E, WM; 694 FEET AND 1929 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 21;

HAROLD BARTSCH - SE¼ NW¼, SECTION 21, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 2640 FEET SOUTH AND 2170 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 21;

HAROLD BARTSCH, successor to F.L. INGRAM - SE¼ NW¼, SECTION 21, T 2 N, R 32 E, WM; NORTH 50° 30' WEST, 470 FEET FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
