CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of GEARY CREEK AND ALLER CREEK, a tributary of SILVES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 225.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2094. The date of priority is DECEMBER 27, 1913. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.81 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4	30.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	28.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	25.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	40.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	22.0 ACRES

SE 1/4 SE 1/4	40.0 ACRES


