CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOUIS F. PRATT AND G. W. PRATT
NORTH POWDER, OREGON 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of ANTHONY CREEK, a tributary of NORTH POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 33.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 252. The date of priority is 1890.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.87 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FROM MARCH 1ST TO JULY 1ST AND 0.41 CFS FROM JULY 1ST TO OCTOBER 1ST OF EACH YEAR; THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED DURING EACH IRRIGATION SEASON NOT TO EXCEED 83 ACRE-FEET, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION IN THE SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 6 S, R 38 E, W.M.; PILCHER-EVANS-FILKINS DITCH - 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 2320 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 18, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 6 S, R 38 E, W.M.; COUGHANOUR DITCH (MCCANSE DITCH)- 1480 FEET SOUTH AND 2630 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 18.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 22, 1951, and together with certificates of water right recorded at page 50928, Volume 45, AND 75592, Volume 76, supersede Certificate 1536, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
