CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MICHAEL MASON ROUTE 1 NORTH POWDER, OREGON 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of ANTHONY CREEK, a tributary of the NORTH POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 97.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 252. The date of priority is 1870 and 1884.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 2.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from March 1st to July 1st, and 1.22 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 243.0 ACRE-FEET, if available at the original point of diversion. (Pilcher-Dryborough Ditch)

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LONE PINE DITCH - NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 6 S, R 38 E, W.M.; 2350 FEET NORTH AND 410 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 17.

PILCHER-DRYBOROUGH DITCH - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 6 S, R 38 E, W.M.; 180 FEET NORTH AND 1430 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 17.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

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NW 1/4 NE 1/4 20.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 28.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 20.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4 17.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 12.5 ACRES
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.
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The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

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This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 21, 1982, and together with Certificates 50928 AND 75591, supersedes Certificate 1536, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
