CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 17.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-1475. The date of priority is OCTOBER 19, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48, SECTION 20, T 11 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH AND 590 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF DLC 48.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 13.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.4 ACRE
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48
SECTION 19

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.2 ACRE
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48
SECTION 20
TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

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
The quantity of water appropriated at the new well shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old well under the subject right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 30, 1981, and supersedes Certificate 33363, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
