CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the water of SNAKE RIVER a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 107.0 ACRES.

The right was perfected under Permit 6742 and the date of priority is MAY 25, 1925. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purpose aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed 1.338 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows: LOT 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) SECTION 28, T 19 S, R 47 E, W.M.; 2560 FEET SOUTH AND 980 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 37391, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 15 1998, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
