CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYMOND C. GELLATLY
BOX 1
PHILOMATH, OREGON 97370

confirms the right to use the waters of GELLATLY CREEK, a tributary of GREASY CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 892. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 8, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 70, SECTION 16, T 12 S, R 6 W, W.M.;
820 FEET SOUTH AND 1500 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.5 ACRE
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 4.0 ACRES
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 16, 1981, and supersedes Certificate 1164, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
