CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TERRY HEEB  
1130 7TH AVENUE  
PAYETTE, IDAHO 83661

confirms the right to use the waters of **A WELL**, tributary of SNAKE RIVER for the purpose of **SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION** of **7.9 acres**.

This right was perfected under Permit U-242. The date of priority is **APRIL 9, 1948**. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed **0.10 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND** or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10, T. 17 S., R. 47 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of **ONE-EIGHTIETH** of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and shall be further limited to a total diversion not to exceed **4 acre feet per acre** during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  TAX LOT 5000 7.90 ACRES  
SECTION 10  
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.

This Certificate describes the new location and type of use of the water right confirmed by Certificate 19810 State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on JAN 25 1999 approving a petition by the Owyhee Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream water rights.
