CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN STACY 3838 BUTTE DRIVE ONTARIO, OREGON 97914

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER, tributary of MALHEUR RIVER for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 5.3 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 20605. The date of priority is **JULY 13, 1951.** The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed **0.13 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND** or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

35 FEET NORTH and 40 FEET EAST from SW corner of SECTION 22, being within SW¹/₄SW¹/₄ of SECTION 22, T. 18 S., R. 46 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of **ONE-FORTIETH** of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and shall be further limited to a total diversion not to exceed **3 acre** feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ TAX LOT 700 5.3 ACRES SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 46 EAST, W.M.

This Certificate describes the new location and type of use of the water right confirmed by Certificate 20594 State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on ___JAN 25 1999 approving a petition by the Owyhee Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream water rights.
