CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT METLEN BOX 553 ONTARIO, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of **UNNAMED SPRING**, tributary of MALHEUR RIVER for the purpose of **SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION** of 3.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 16760. The date of priority is **NOVEMBER 28, 1945.** The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed **0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND** or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

300 FEET SOUTH. and 1540 FEET WEST from the E½ corner of SECTION 9, being within the $NW^{1}/4$ SE½ of SECTION 9, T. 18 S., R. 46 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of **ONE-TWENTIETH** of one cubic foot per acre (or its equivalent) and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated in any 30 day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated in any 30 day period after June 1st and shall be further limited to a total diversion not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Tax Lot 3000 3.5 ACRES Section 9 TOWHSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 46 EAST, W.M.

This Certificate describes the new location and type of use of the water right confirmed by Certificate
21737 State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Recovery Director entered on
Resources Director entered onapproving a petition by the Owyh
Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream water rights.
