## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

has a right to the use of

for the purpose of the irrigation of 62 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6 , at page 291 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876 for Tract 1: 1882 for Tract 2: 1905 for Tract 3: 1878 for Tract 4:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic feet per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 12 acres in SE NW1;

N. Gould.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
