CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BEN IMADA
1310 AIRPORT ROAD
ONTARIO, OREGON 97914

confirms the right to use the waters of **IMADA WELL**, in the MALHUER RIVER BASIN for for the purpose of **SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 72.8 ACRES**.

This right was perfected under Permit G-32. The date of priority is **SEPTEMBER 14, 1955**. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed **0.91 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND** or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation from the source.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

SE1/4 NW1/4, SECTION 24, T. 16 S., R. 47 E., W.M.; 2600 FEET SOUTH and 500 FEET WEST from the N1/4 corner of SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to **ONE-EIGHTIETH** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre-feet** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ TAX LOT 2500 35.8 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ TAX LOT 2500 37.0 ACRES
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.

This Certificate describes the new location and type of use of the water right confirmed by Certificate 26372 State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on JAN 25 1999 approving a petition by the Owyhee Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream water rights.
