CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 172.1 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1883.

The use is limited to not more than 4.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

TRAVILLION KOESTER DITCH

SW ¼ NW ¼, SECTION 1, T 7 S, R 39 E, WM; BEING 200 FEET NORTH AND 870 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.
