CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOE L. AND SALLY MOYA
ROUTE 4, BOX 415A
BANDON, OREGON 97411

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of the COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 3.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 18645. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1949. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 32, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year for any crop except cranberries, and 0.1 cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6.0 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year for cranberries.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.3 ACRES
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 21685, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 24 1998, approving Transfer Application 7801.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
