CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GUM CREEK FARMS INC. 5070 SOUTH ROAD K VALE, OR 97918

confirms the right to use the waters of GUM CREEK, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 73.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 46.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 21750. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 4, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 43 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
