CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of LOG DECK SPRINKLING.

This right has been perfected under Permit 44679. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 27, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.04 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M.; 870 FEET SOUTH AND 900 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 21

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
