confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.2 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of paragraphs 24 and 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE% SW%, SECTION 22, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; 700 FEET NORTH AND 780 FEET WEST FROM THE S% CORNER, SECTION 22.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ 2.2 ACRES SECTION 16 TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 2535, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered __________, approving Transfer Application 7950.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
