CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 40675. The date of priority is APRIL 7, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, WM; 720 FEET NORTH AND 710 FEET EAST FROM THE C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 33.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 33 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, WM

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
