CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PETER J. PON  
ROUTE 2, BOX 1410

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for 48.33 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 24057. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.607 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW¼ NE¼, as projected within HANNON DLC 42, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2¼ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ 8.00 ACRES  
SE¼ NW¼ 22.53 ACRES  
NE¼ SW¼ 17.00 ACRES  
NW¼ SE¼ 0.80 ACRES

as projected within HANNON DLC 42  
SECTION 27  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 28416, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 20 1998, approving Transfer Application 7110.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
