CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. W. BARRON
ASHLAND, OR 97520

confirms the right to use the water of SLIDE GULCH, a tributary of HILL CREEK, and an UNNAMED TRIBUTARY of Hill Creek for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 57.76 ACRES and DOMESTIC USE from Slide Gulch and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF SAID 57.76 ACRES and DOMESTIC USE from Unnamed Tributary of Hill Creek.

The right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1; the priority of the right dates from 1853.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purpose aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed 0.747 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from all sources, subject to the provisions of paragraph 79 of said decree.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 15945, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 23 1998, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
