## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE DES BRISAY CANBY, OREGON 97013

confirms the right to use the waters of the MOLALLA RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 56.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 21320. The date of priority is APRIL 16, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.71 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 7 (NW¼ SE¼), SECTION 20; NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 29, T 3 S, R 1 E, WM; 4200 FEET NORTH AND 2610 FEET WEST; 1450 FEET NORTH AND 3160 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE E¼ CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

2.6 ACRES LOT 8 (NE¼ SE¼) 7.6 ACRES LOT 7 (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) 16.2 ACRES SW1/4 SE1/4 SE¼ SE¼ 13.4 ACRES SECTION 20

2.4 ACRES NE1/4 NE1/4 NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 14.6 ACRES **SECTION 29** 

## TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 74441, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 2 3 1998, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
