confirms the right to store the WASTE WATER, a tributary of BLACK JACK CREEK, in WASTE LAGOON, appropriated under Permit 44405, for the purpose of IRRIGATION AND DAIRY BARN USE.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-7935. The date of priority is JUNE 18, 1979. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 19.9 acre feet.


The reservoir is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The dam is to be operated and maintained in accordance to the approved plans and specifications.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
