CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH FORK ALSEA RIVER, a tributary of the ALSEA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 21.9 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 35053. The date of priority is APRIL 13, 1970. The right is limited to not more than 0.28 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 6, T 14 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 625 FEET NORTH AND 1225 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 4, 1980, and together with certificate 43543 and a Order of the Water Resources Director approving transfer application number T-3352, supersedes certificate 41663, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
