## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GARY L. AND ROMA B. JACKSON 7917 N MYRTLE ROAD MYRTLE CREEK, OREGON 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH MYRTLE CREEK, a tributary of MYRTLE CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 879. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1911. The right is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 29 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1130 FEET SOUTH AND 1090 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4).

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.2 ACRES SECTION 5 TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 25, 1981, and together with Certificates 64739, 64587, 50331 and Order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer No. 4804 supersedes Certificate 44821, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
