CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES A. WHITE 203 ROCK STREET SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

confirms the right to use the waters of ABIQUA CREEK, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 5.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 28850. The date of priority is MAY 27, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITH SHEPARD DLC 38, SECTION 28, T 6 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 2867 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET EAST FROM THE WESTERLY NW CORNER, SHEPARD DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.1 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.5 ACRES BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN SHEPARD DLC 38 SECTION 28 TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install head gates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 17, 1981 AND TOGETHER WITH CERTIFICATE 50344 supersedes Certificate 34699, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
