CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANK P. AND CLARA A. MOAN
SOUTH MYRTLE ROUTE, BOX 226
MYRTLE CREEK, OREGON 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH MYRTLE CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 18769. The date of priority is MAY 19, 1949. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 7 (NE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 21, T 29 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1000 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF B. L. STEPHENS DLC 38.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 3, 1982, and supersedes Certificate 19573, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
