CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E. N. FEARRIEN PAULINA, OREGON 97751

confirms the right to use the waters of PAULINA CREEK, a tributary of BEAVER CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 294.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 14085. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 28, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.68 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW¼ SE¼, SECTION 17, T. 16 S., R. 23 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
