CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES D. ROSE AND E.M. GRAHAM  
PENDLETON, OREGON 97801

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.40 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 652. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼            0.40 ACRE  
SECTION 16  
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68339, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 26, 1997, approving Transfer Application 7157, and orders of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 30 1998, approving Transfer Applications 7106 and 7107.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
