CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RODNEY P. ROLFE
GRASS VALLEY, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 39.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 26435. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 2, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 20; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 29; TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.6 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 13.4 ACRES
SECTION 20

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 13.6 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.0 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.5 ACRES
SECTION 29

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 38666, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 02 1998, approving Transfer Application 7963.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
