CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ETHEL HITCHCOCK
SISTERS, OREGON 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 5.43 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Pages 120 and 471. The date of priority is 1885.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SMITH DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.43 ACRES
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12307, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 02 1998, approving Transfer Application 7958.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
