CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J.C. RUBY MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST AND WEST BRANCHES OF CROCKETT BRANCH OF LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 6.97 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1892 for 2.89 acres, 1898 for 2.04 acres, and 1903 for 2.04 acres. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 10.46 MINER'S INCHES (0.26 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE AND ONE-HALF MINERS INCHES PER ACRE, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE¼ NE¼, SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 26, T 6 N, R 35 E, WM; WEST BRANCH POD - 20 FEET NORTH AND 440 FEET WEST FROM THE E¼ CORNER, SECTION 26; EAST BRANCH POD - 22 FEET NORTH AND 1316 FEET EAST FROM THE S¼ CORNER, SECTION 26.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ 6.97 ACRES SECTION 26 TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
