CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RONALD A. MOORE
901 N.W. CHADWICK LANE

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 40.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 12200. The date of priority is JUNE 1, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW¼ NW¼, AS PROJECTED WITH BAILEY DLC 40, SECTION 7, T30S, R5W, WM; 40 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTHIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ 0.5 ACRE
SE¼ SW¼ 5.5 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN BAILEY DLC 40
SECTION 6

NW¼ NW¼ 34.1 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN BAILEY DLC 40
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to correct the location of the point of diversion and the place of use and describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 45744, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 05 1996, approving Transfer Application 6059.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
