CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DRY GULCH DITCH COMPANY ROUTE 1, BOX 102A RICHLAND, OR 97870

confirms the right to use the waters of Dry Gulch Draw (a.k.a. first of Two Draws), Tributary of Waterbury and Dry Gulch Ditches, tributary of POWDER RIVER, tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 30.50 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4838 and has a date of priority of MARCH 22, 1920.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

#12 Dry Gulch SE¼ SW¼, Section 21, T9S, R45E, W.M.; 30' North and 1775' East from the Southwest corner of Section 21, T9S, R45E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
