CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DRY GULCH DITCH COMPANY ROUTE 1, BOX 102A RICHLAND, OR 97870

confirms the right to use the waters of Lower Timber Canyon (a.k.a. Coin Creek or Three Canyon Creek), tributary of POWDER RIVER, tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 14.00 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291.

The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

#11 Simonis Ditch SW¼ SW¼, Section 29, T9S, R45E, W.M.; 620' North and 790' East from the Southwest corner of Section 29, T9S, R45E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate, together with Certificate 75862, supersedes Certificate 4463 and confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on FFB 1 6 1999 approving a petition by Dry Gulch Ditch Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.
