CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A.H. LAWRENCE  
MORGAN HILL, CALIFORNIA 95037

confirms the right to use the waters of TRAIL CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 14.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1898.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

INLOW DITCH.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  9.2 ACRES  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  4.8 ACRES  
SECTION 33  
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate correctly describes that portion of the water right NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 21, 1998, approving Transfer Application 6824, and supercedes Certificate 75804, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
