CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. J. and LORRAINE B. JONES

confirms the right to use the water of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.5 ACRES.

The right was perfected under Permit No. 20004 and the date of priority is DECEMBER 19, 1950. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purpose aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW¼ NW¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN CHRISMAN DLC 51, SECTION 27, T4S, R3W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 3 (NW¼ NW¼) 1.0 ACRES
SECTION 27

LOT 1 (NE¼ NE¼) 1.5 ACRES
SECTION 28

TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 24795, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 02 1998, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
