CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN A. LIDELL, JR.
ROUTE 1, BOX 255
TERREBONNE, OREGON 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 12 in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 56.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4396. The date of priority is APRIL 15, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.70 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the ORIGINAL wells; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T 14 S, R 12 E, WM; Well 5 - 300 feet South and 40 feet West, Well 6 - 1260 feet South and 40 feet West, Well 8 - 2350 feet South and 1060 feet West, all from the NE corner, Section 20, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The AUTHORIZED point of appropriation (well) is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 21, T 14 S, R 12 E, W.M.; WELL 12 - 550 FEET SOUTH AND 120 FEET EAST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	0.1 ACRE
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	9.6 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	32.6 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	2.3 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	11.2 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	0.3 ACRE

SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

the pump system shall include an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 67899, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 25 1998, approving Transfer Application 6836

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
