CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. A. LIDELL, JR. ROUTE 1, BOX 255 TERREBONNE, OREGON 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of 4 WELLS in the DESCHUTES BASIN for IRRIGATING 25.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8698. The date of priority is JUNE 19, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.31 CFS FROM WELLS 5, 6, AND 11, AND 0.01 CFS FROM WELL 12, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

NE¼ NE¼, SECTION 20; NW¼ NE¼, SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 21, ALL IN T 14 S, R 12 E, W.M.; WELL 5 - 300 FEET SOUTH AND 40 FEET WEST, WELL 6 - 1260 FEET SOUTH AND 40 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 20; WELL 11 - 350 FEET NORTH AND 400 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 21, WELL 12 - 550 FEET SOUTH AND 120 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.
