CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CLYDE AND JACQUELINE REED 13905 NW WILLIS ROAD McMINNVILLE. OR 97128

confirms the right to use the waters of McCALL SPRING, a tributary of BERRY CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 6.9 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 45097. The date of priority is JUNE 23, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.055 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.05 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 1, T 4 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 30 FEET NORTH AND 240 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF DLC 55.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 3.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 3.7 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
