CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROYAL CROWN CATTLE COMPANY
P.O. BOX 57
SILVER LAKE, OREGON 97638

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATING 340.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8600. The date of priority is APRIL 23, 1979. This right is limited to not mor than 4.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 28 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 2260 FEET SOUTH AND 290 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


